Darla Haggard Goulla is a Texas-based advocate and new delegate with Toll and Roll™. She and her husband have been married for 33 years, and their family includes daughters, grandchildren, and relatives they have helped raise.

Darla relocated to Texas in 1982 and joined Abbott Laboratories, where she worked for two decades. Beginning in Production in 1983, she later served as an MQA Inspector, supervised a seven person production line, and audited work orders for accuracy. She ultimately resigned due to health issues.

In 2003, Darla became a dispatcher for Westside Towing, collaborating remotely with local police and emergency services. Since then, she has dedicated her time to managing household responsibilities and caring for family members.

Since 2013, Darla has raised documented concerns regarding systemic fraud, especially within housing and financial systems. In 2024, she served as a Grand Juror at the Del Rio, Texas Federal Court, participating in monthly, and occasionally bi-monthly, case hearings.

After traveling with the Toll and Roll™ Delegation and meeting Oklahoma State Representative Justin Humphrey in Washington, D.C. in September 2025, Darla expanded her awareness of fraud issues impacting her home state. She continues to support accountability efforts and advocates for individuals harmed by actions in the courts, including misconduct by judges, county recorders, sheriffs, attorneys, and related officials.

As a Texas State Representative working on The Petition of Remonstrance, Darla has provided updates regarding current facts and violations to the Governor, the Attorney General, and the Williamson County Court. She has also communicated with contacts in Washington, D.C., whose identities she prefers to keep confidential at this time.
